

Rules for Queen of Hearts

Queen of Hearts is a 50/50 progressive raffle, fifty percent going to the Queen of Hearts winner and fifty percent going to VFW Post 1988. There is a winner every week.

The week's jackpot is posted next to the Queen of Hearts board. The jackpot amount is the combined previous week's unclaimed 50% total amount.

A winning ticket will be drawn from the raffle drum EVERY TUESDAY AT 7:00 PM and announced.

There are 52 cards and 2 jokers for a total of 54 cards. For a chance to draw for the Queen of Hearts, purchase your tickets (3 tickets for \$5.00). ALL TICKETS MUST HAVE YOUR LEGAL FIRST AND LAST NAME, PHONE NUMBER, AND CARD NUMBER YOU ARE CHOOSING ON THE BACK OF THE TICKET. IF THE NAME ON THE TICKET IS NOT LEGIBLE, THE TICKET WILL BE CONSIDERED VOID AND ANOTHER TICKET WILL BE DRAWN. IF THERE IS NO CARD NUMBER ON YOUR TICKET, ONE OF THE PRESENT BARTENDERS WILL MAKE THE SELECTION FOR YOU.

If the Queen of Hearts is chosen, the game ends. If not, that person will be paid the prize for the card drawn.

JOKER RESET: If the second Joker is revealed before the Queen is found the game ends. A new game will begin the following week with a new game board. The jackpot will carry over to the new game, less the Joker amount.

After a card is selected, it is removed from play. After each week's drawing, all tickets will be destroyed. To remain in play, you must purchase new tickets each week.

When the game ends, the new Queen of Hearts game pot will start at \$500 minimum. This amount is determined by half of the previous week's ticket sales. If those sales are less than \$500, the difference will be made up by VFW Post 1988.

Players must be a member of a VFW Post or one of its Auxiliaries. Must be 18 years of age to participate.

Tickets are sold at 3 for \$5.00.

No group tickets are allowed. Each ticket sold must have one authorized person's name. Please do not write nicknames, initials or abbreviations for the sake of possible confusion. The only exception to that rule is: If a member chooses to donate their winnings, any reference to VFW Post 1988 is okay: (e.g., Post 1988, VFW 1988, 1988, or Post).

It is the responsibility of the players to be sure the ticket with their name is in the raffle drum.

Tickets placed in the drum will be disqualified if there is evidence of tampering, i.e., applying stickers, folding, rolling, tearing, crumpling, etc. No hands are allowed to reach into the drum while a game is in progress, except to draw a ticket at the end of that night's game, NO exceptions.

The winning ticket will pay out as follows:

Numbered cards from Two through Ten will pay 6 free tickets for the next drawing.

Face cards and Aces (Except the Queen of Hearts) will pay \$20.00.

Jokers will pay \$50.00.

The Queen of Hearts card (The Game Winner) will receive half the proceeds from the total through the previous week payable by \$500.00 cash, with the remainder by check to be picked up at the VFW Post 1988 office by the winner the following weekday.
